AN ENCOURAGING FIRST SEASON FOR R-ACE GP IN ADAC F4

Now that the 2019 ADAC F4 season is over, it's time to look at R-ace GP's results and progression in this championship.

To embark on a new championship was a challenge for R-ace GP, who's specialised in Formula Renault. The team had to learn everything: the car, with a Tatuus chassis and an Abarth engine; the championship, with experienced opponents; and the circuits, most of which are located in Germany.

R-ace GP entered the competition with two drivers, Grégoire Saucy and Laszlo Toth, joined by SMP Racing driver Michael Belov from the second meeting, and by Hadrien David for rounds 5 and 6 in Zandvoort and at the Nürburgring.

In 7 meetings and 20 races, R-ace GP drivers were on the podium 3 times. The season even finished in a blaze of glory with a win for Belov during race 1 at the Sachsenring.

Those results are the evidence of the progress made by the team, the whole season long, with a better understanding of the car. 4th in the teams' standings after the last race, R-ace GP has proven its worth in the championship organised by ADAC.

In 2020, R-ace GP will come back stronger. For its second season consecutive in ADAC F4, the objectives will be increased to confirm the French team's step up. More podiums, more wins.
